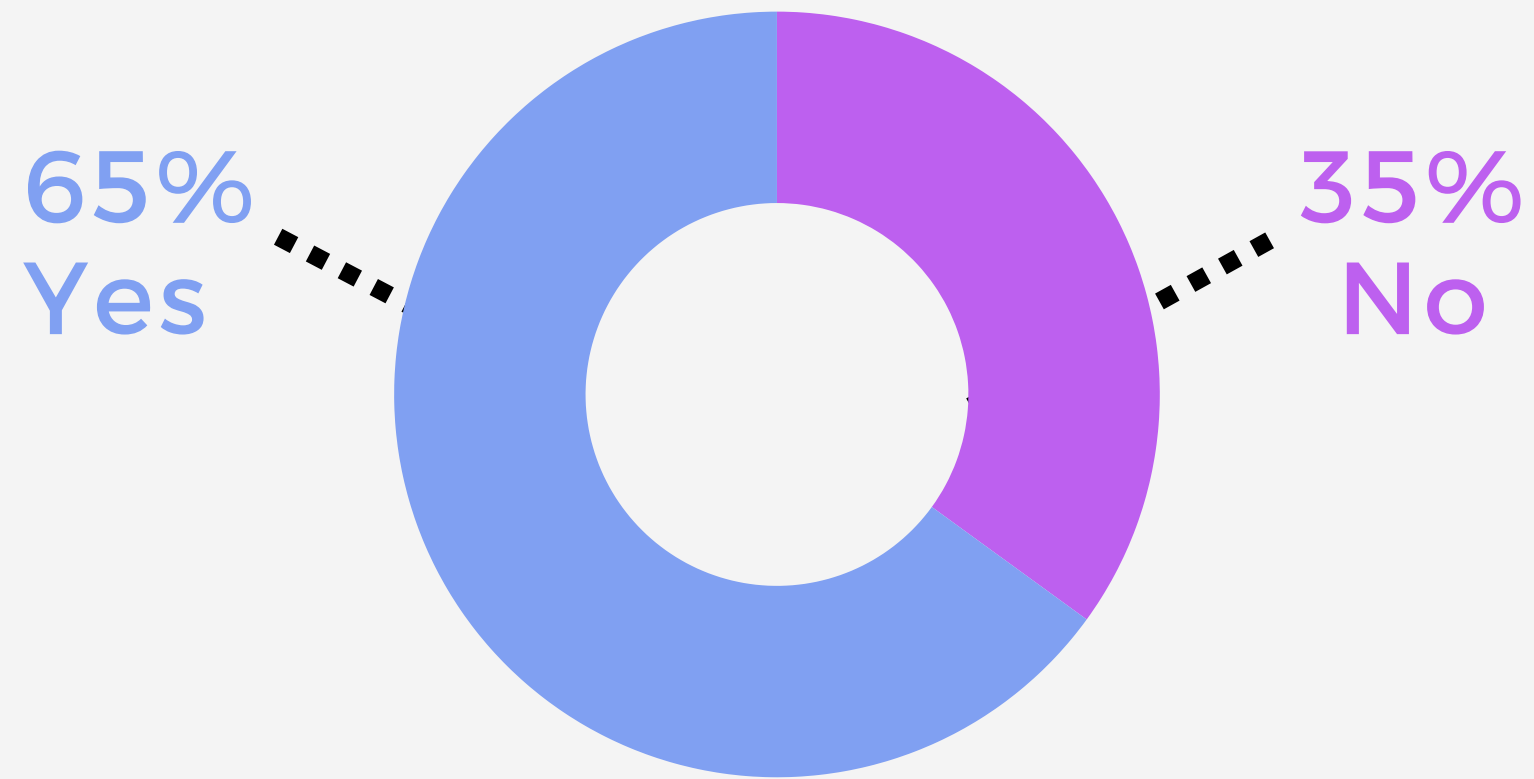

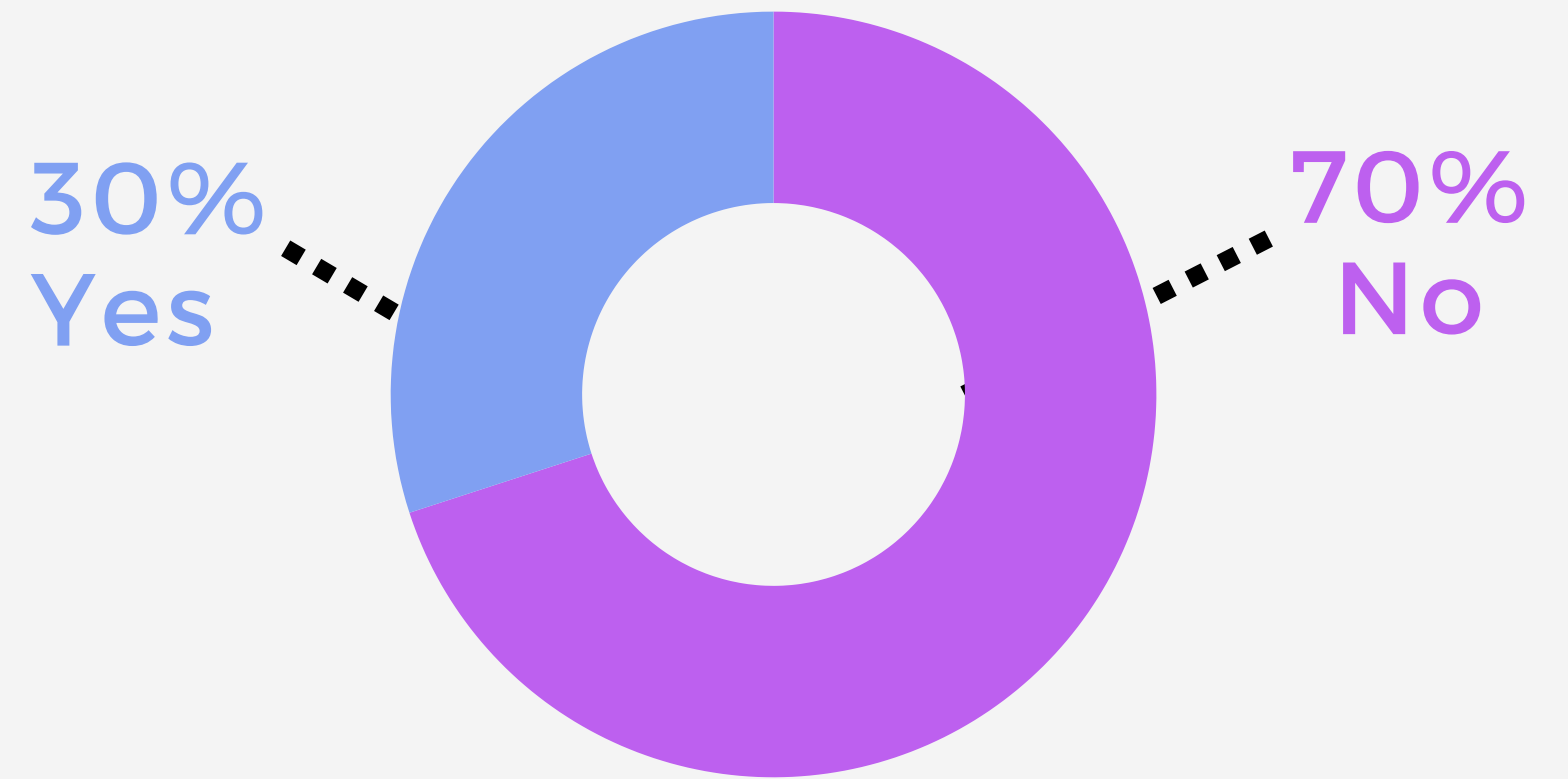

BULLIED.**

ANONYMOUS WAYS OF  
REPORTING BULLYING WORKED  
BEST TO AVOID BEING  
ACCUSED OF "SNITCHING".






**90% OF PRIMARY ATTENDEES AND  
80% OF SECONDARY FELT THAT  
AN ANTI-BULLYING LEAD IN  
SCHOOLS WAS A GOOD IDEA.**

**SECONDARY ADDED THAT THIS  
SHOULD BE A PAID ROLE BECAUSE  
OF THE EXTRA WORK INVOLVED.**
